


- Sustained low uranium prices

Orano Canada: McClean Lake



- Located over 750 km north of Saskatoon and 400 km (via road) north of La Ronge in the Athabasca Basin region
- Over 20% of the world's annual uranium production comes from the Athabasca Basin



The world's highest grade uranium ore mine

*as of December 31, 2017

The only mill designed to produce high-grade uranium ore without dillution

- Mine type: underground mine
- Mining technique: **Jet-Boring**
- Total packaged production in **2017**: **6.9 tU (18 M lbs.** U₃O₈)
- Mill production capacity: 9,200 tU/year (24 M lbs. U₃O₈) with 18 mlbs dedicated to Cigar Lake production

Supply Chain Management: How To Become A Vendor To Orano

- Request and complete a vendor pre-qualification form
 - Company background, financial stability, capabilities, references
- Site Audits
 - Orano may be required to audit your site to review safety, quality & production processes
- RFQ
 - RFQ's would be issued if the vendor prequalification and audit has been acceptable to Orano
- Bid Evaluation
 - Price, quality, service, delivery, key personnel, adherence to technical specifications
